RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council ratify the City's application to GRIC to Fund the Coolidge Emergency Housing Repair Program.

DISCUSSION

The City of Coolidge has successfully applied to GRIC for tribal gaming funds in the past. Staff was not able to schedule this item for Council action prior to the application deadline which is why we are asking for ratification. The project involves funding a program that can quickly address owner occupied housing emergencies within the low-to-moderate income population of Coolidge. The goal would be to apply a maximum of \$15,000.00 per household, to repair items such as air-conditioning units, collapsed sewer lines, dangerous electrical issues, etc.

If this project is selected for funding, we will be back before the City Council for approval to accept the award and to pass a Resolution supporting the action.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated cost of the Coolidge Emergency Housing Repair Program is approximately \$75,000.00. If there is only partial funding available, the program would still be able to help some of the citizens seeking emergency housing repairs.
