**SUBJECT: Cellebrite Software Purchase  
with ICAC Awarded Grant Funds**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Police staff recommends the City Council approve accepting a \$15,000.00 grant awarded to the City of Coolidge Police Department from the Phoenix Police Department/AZ ICAC Task Force for the purchase of Cellebrite Software by June 30, 2018.

**DISCUSSION**

Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Police staff applied for a total of \$22,319.00 from the AZ ICAC Task Force for the purchase of Cellebrite software (\$15,900.00), Cellebrite training (\$3,850.00), and Oxygen Forensic software renewal (\$2,399.00). In years past Coolidge Police Department is usually awarded no more than \$2000.00 from AZ ICAC to cover the majority of the Oxygen Forensic software renewal, however this year we received \$15,000.00 to purchase Cellebrite Software by JUNE 30, 2018.

Cellebrite is the sole developer and manufacturer of the Universal Forensic Extraction Device (UFED) Mobile Forensic solution. See sole source letter attached. Cellebrite is a mobile forensic extraction, decoding, and analysis tool that extracts logical, file system, and physical data from mobile devices (i.e., smartphones, cell phones, tablets, GPS units, SIM cards, memory cards, and USB devices), including live and deleted data, phone numbers, call logs, text messages, SMS messages, app data (social network and other), location data, pictures, videos, and voice messages. Mobile Forensic data extraction is now an industry norm and jury expected investigative technique.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Fiscal Year 2017/18 there was no negative financial impact. Oxygen Forensic software renewal was paid for out of general funds. The Cellebrite training (\$3,850) will be funded by our current training budget GL# 10-532-271, the Cellebrite equipment and software will be funded out of the AZ ICAC GL#20-587-285 not to exceed \$15,000 to be expended and reimbursed by June 30, 2018, and the remaining balance of \$2,437.40 (tax, remaining software and equipment balance, and shipping) will be funded out of GL#10-532-285.

Annual Cellebrite software renewal including Oxygen Forensic software, totaling approximately \$8,000.00 will be requested for reimbursement through the AZ ICAC grant thus creating no



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negative financial impact to the City.
