RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the Resolution approving submission of an Application to the Gila River Indian Community for the Coolidge Cultural Resources Identification Program from Proposition 202 Gaming Funds, and accepting the grant.

DISCUSSION

The City of Coolidge recognizes the importance and the historical and cultural value of the Casa Grande Ruins National Monument. Because of our proximity, there are areas within the City limits that contain culturally sensitive resources. The City wants to identify potential areas where important cultural resources may be present and develop strategies to properly address these areas during construction or ground disturbing activities. These funds will be used to pay for a study and map system that will identify areas of potential resources and ultimately develop a programmatic agreement.

Currently we do not have any open Proposition 202 grants.

The deadline for submission of a resolution of support is September 25, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT

\$45,000 in one year.
