

RESOLUTION No. 18-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COOLIDGE, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT, IGA/JPA NO. 18-0007036-I BETWEEN THE STATE OF ARIZONA ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF COOLIDGE FOR THE RUINS DRIVE AT SR 87 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed in IGA/JPA No. 18-0007036-I (“Agreement”) between the State of Arizona acting by and through its Department of Transportation and the City of Coolidge includes the design and construction of a new traffic signal at the intersection of State Route 87 and Ruins Drive in Coolidge (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the State will design, advertise, bid, award, and administer the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project will be performed, completed, accepted, and paid for in accordance with the requirements of the Project plans and specifications and will require no matching funds from the City; and

WHEREAS, after final inspection and acceptance of the Project is complete, the City will assume the electric costs of the traffic signal and lighting; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Coolidge, Arizona believe it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Coolidge to enter into the Agreement with the State of Arizona acting by and through its Department of Transportation in connection with the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Coolidge, Arizona that the Mayor for the City of Coolidge is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Intergovernmental Agreement, IGA/JPA No. 18-0007036-I between the State of Arizona, acting by and through its Department of Transportation and the City of Coolidge for the State Route 87 and Ruins Drive Project.
